

Update #16 - Testonline Implements Customizable Achievement Level Reports!

[1. Users can now generate achievement level reports!](#)

Beginning September 8th, 2009, users of Testonline's diagnostic math assessment tests online can generate custom-defined achievement level reports for all four strands. District coordinators can set their own district's achievement levels (in percent), as well as the names for those levels. Users - teachers, school administrators and district-office staff - can generate reports at the division, school and/or district level.

Teachers, using a username and password of their own choosing, can log in to the Administration Zone of Testonline.ca. After selecting the report parameters from drop-down list-boxes, they can generate any of six reports on each of their divisions. Both student and aggregate reports in PDF are available, as well as databases in XLS file format.

School administrators (principals and vice principals) can similarly generate reports on all the divisions in their school, plus four reports on all divisions combined in the school for a particular test.

District Coordinators can generate all division and school-level reports as well as four district-wide reports.

Benefits for Teachers and School Administrators:

- See at a glance the progress of their students using district-wide achievement level criteria.
- Generate reports in real time from any computer with access to the Internet.

Benefits for District Coordinators:

- Assess the progress of all divisions using district-wide customizable achievement levels.
- Generate district-wide reports to assess overall progress towards goals.

Teachers and administrators will improve the effectiveness of classroom instruction by having access to high-quality diagnostic data that enables them to efficiently allocate resources to areas of need. Vital information about individual student, division, school and district achievement is available upon completion.

The average-size school district in BC would use about 188,000 sheets (about 40 boxes) of paper to administer the DMA tests to all its students twice per year. Using our online service, the total number of sheets of paper used is 0.
